

GeelongPort is excited to welcome Spirit of Tasmania to Geelong in 2022 and is building a new passenger and freight terminal to support the long-term operations of this iconic service.

Project overview

Spirit of Tasmania is moving its Victorian operations from Port Melbourne to Geelong in 2022. The relocation will provide an improved experience for the 450,000 passengers who travel annually and support the long-term operations of this highly valued service.

GeelongPort is investing \$135 million to construct a new passenger and freight terminal to support Spirit of Tasmania's operations. The new 12-hectare site will include:

- Purpose-built passenger terminal building
- Passenger vehicle marshalling area for 600 cars
- Trailer and parking area for 150 trucks
- Security facilities
- Office facilities and crew accommodation
- Public amenities
- Café
- Children's play area

As Victoria's second-largest port, GeelongPort has been an integral part of Geelong's economic and social fabric for more than 150 years, helping to transform the city and region into the economic, tourism and community hub it is today. GeelongPort comprises 15 berths across two primary precincts, one of which is Corio Quay.

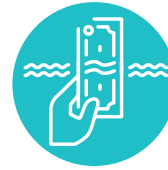

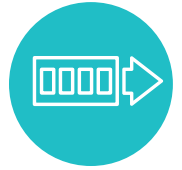

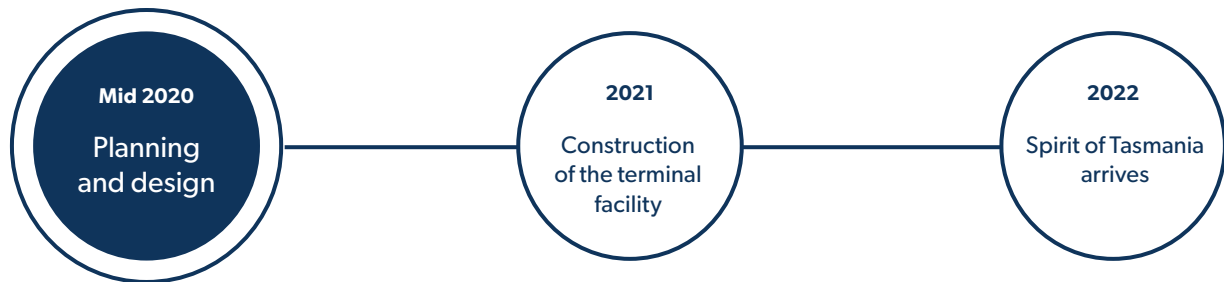
